Confidentiality	<i>All survey responses will be collected and analyzed anonymously. This information will be stored on a password-protected server. To prevent duplicate participation, we will collect participants' MTurk ID, IP address, and use cookies. After this study is completed, all data used in this study will be destroyed.</i> <i>If we write a report or article about this research project, your identity will be protected to the maximum extent possible. Your information may be shared with representatives of the University of Maryland, College Park or governmental authorities if you or someone else is in danger or if we are required to do so by law.</i>
Compensation	<i>After you successfully complete the survey, you will receive \$1.50 paid to your MTurk account. You will be responsible for all taxes assessed on this compensation.</i> <i>You are only allowed to participate once – if we find you participating a second time, you will not be paid again.</i>
